Overall very satisfied:

- 1-Price was disclosed accurately up front- no hidden fees, all taxes included in quote, completely straightforward.
- 2-Answered all emails very promptly and the cusomter sales staff were very curtious and professional.
- 3-Clear responses to all my queries.
- 4-Took prompt action on my request to change my address in Ireland.
- 5-The onsite packing team was very professional and knew their job well.
- 6-Paper work and insurance work was prompt, efficient and quick,

Minor downsides:

1-Out of the 8 boxes, 4 boxes were reopened and repacked (most likely or may be) by the Customs (in India or in Ireland, not sure). The boxes were not packed

properly (the plastic over was removed and the boxes were only taped) the same way as it was done initially by Agarwal Packers and movers. Having said that,

no item was missing or was lost. This is one suggestion to Agarwal packers and movers, if possible for them to provide a feedback to customs to

ensure they repack the goods in same fashion as before.

- 2-One kitchen item (handle of one Pressure cooker) was broken. Though, everything else was safe.
- 3-Price quote was little higher than most the competitor's quotes. But, I think better service compensates for the same.
