

Agarwal Packers and Movers Ltd. (APML) recently signed an MOU for setting up of 'Multi-Modal Integrated Logistics Parks' at the India Integrated Logistics and Transport 2017 summit, held under the aegis of MORTH. APML suggested 4 logistics gateways i.e. Dudu (Rajasthan) for North, Jamshedpur for East, Malegoan (Maharashtra) for West and Hosur (TN) for South. APML also suggested use Malkapur in Maharashtra as National Distribution Hub due to its central location. All these locations with integrated multi-modal parks will become pivot for all transportation and supply chain activities.

Ramesh Agarwal - Chairman, Agarwal Packers and Movers Ltd. (APML) recently also announced investment worth Rs. 650 crores for setting up of logistics parks in the country. He said, "These Multi-Modal hubs will benefit the transport industry to a great extent and will also help in reducing India's logistics cost and bring them closer to the accepted global benchmarks (i.e.8 to 8.5%) from the current high levels of 13-14% of GDP". At present in India an annual loss of 42000 crore occur due to





transshipment, while transporting the goods from one place to another. Till now it was unavoidable but APML has redefined the word unavoidable by introducing Trucking Cube for Zero Transsipment. He further added that Indian logistics sector will benefit from all these initiatives and GST regime would also act as a catalyst for change.

One of the main reasons for the introduction of this system is to ensure safe movement of goods from one place to another even if the transport vehicle breaks down. In case of a breakdown, goods are not physically offloaded from truck but transferred as it is with same cube to the new vehicle. While the move is cost effective, it also comes with added safety. Since the goods are in a closed container, they are immune to weather changes and natural causes such as rusting.
